8.30am Depart Melbourne on the M1 Monash Freeway and make your way to the South Gippsland Hwy.

Stop and refresh at Australian Garden, Cranbourne to be inspired by the beauty and diversity of Australian Flora, landscapes, art and architecture.

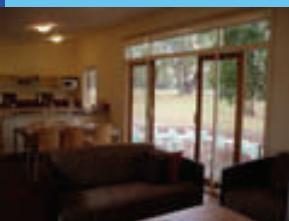
Travel on to the fishing village of San Remo and at 12 noon daily enjoy the daily pelican feeding at the Jetty where local fisherman have returned from their morning fishing expeditions. San Remo the gateway to Phillip Island has a fishing village atmosphere with views across Westernport to Phillip Island and Bass Strait.

Follow the bridge and you pass through Newhaven, continue on the main road and you will pass the airport where Phillip Island Helicopters run a vast array of scenic flights over the Island. Why not see the Island and scenic coastline from up above.

Follow the signs to Cowes and stop off at A Maze N Things to enjoy a series of unique and interactive exhibits that entertain, intrigue and stimulate adults for hours.

Drive onto your accommodation base with a range of new resorts, quality apartments, holiday parks and bed & breakfasts on offer you will be in for a restful overnight stay. Enjoy dining at one of the many seaside restaurants such as Harry's on The Esplanade who use fresh local seafood and produce before preparing for your natural encounter at the Penguin Parade.

Travel only 10 minutes by car to the world famous Penguin Parade located at the Western tip of the Island. Visit the visitors centre to learn the history of these little creatures and their nightly pilgrimage before you head out to the beach. There are a number of penguin viewing experiences to choose from including ranger lead tours and enhanced viewing areas.





Day 2

Start the day with an invigorating walk at The Nobbies. Boardwalks provide breathtaking vistas of the cliff top coastline and blowhole. Visit the The Nobbies centre to learn more about the marine environment surrounding Phillip Island and Western Port.



Travel 15 minutes by car to the seaside village of Rhyll at The Foreshore Restaurant enjoying the tranquil view of Westernport. Enjoy a bottle of local wine while indulging in culinary delights at this popular establishment.



1.30pm Make your way to the Cowes Jetty to catch a cruise (2pm) for a seal rock experience aboard Wildlife Coast Cruises. This trip sees you amongst one of the largest frolicking Australian Fur Seal colonies and will leave you fascinated with their antics in and out of the water. This is a unique experience for any wildlife lover.
