



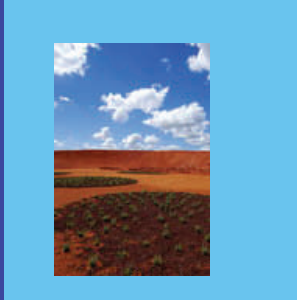
Phillip Island Touring Itinerary Suggestions

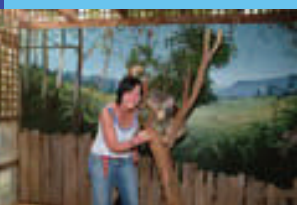

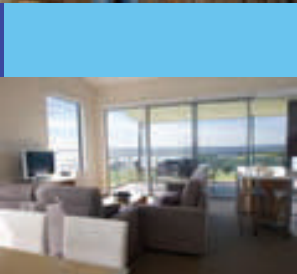
Options

Lunch and Farm Tour at Warrook Cattle Farm, Monomeith learn about an Australian Cattle Farm



Or

Visit Maru Koala and Fauna Park to get up close to wallabies, koalas, wombats and Tassie devils. Enjoy a round of mini golf at the parks unique course.



Drive onto your accommodation base with a range of new resorts, quality apartments, holiday parks and bed & breakfasts on offer you will be in for a restful overnight stay. Accommodation is scattered from San Remo to all over the Island. Enjoy dining at one of the many seaside restaurants like Harry's on the Esplanade and prepare for your natural encounter at the Penguin Parade.




Travel to the world famous Penguin Parade located at the Western tip of the Island no more than 20 minutes from anywhere on the Island. Visit the visitors centre to learn about these little creatures and their nightly pilgrimage before you head out to the beach. There are a number of penguin parade experiences to choose from including ranger lead experiences and enhanced viewing areas.

Day 2



Start the day with an invigorating walk at one of the many walking trails including Rhyll Inlet, Swan Lake or Cape Woolamai. Visit The Nobbies and enjoy the boardwalks with incredible cliff top views of Bass Strait. The centre has an educational area and café to enjoy the views. Cameras at Seal Rocks allow you to view the seals in their natural home.



Visit the home of the Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix at the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit and take an action packed ride in a go kart, or enjoy a behind the scenes tour of the Circuit including Control Tower and winner's podium. There is fascinating history at the motor sport display and action a plenty at the slot cars.



Venture down to Cowes the Island's main township to have lunch at Harry's on the Esplanade before you catch a cruise to seal rocks aboard Wildlife Coast Cruises (2pm). This trip sees you amongst one of the largest frolicking Australian Fur Seal colonies and will leave you fascinated with their antics in and out of the water.


Return to wander the shops and cafes of the township of Cowes. Dine at one of the fine water view restaurants and take in all that the Island's local produce and wine has to offer or venture out to the Rhyll Fishing Park and Restaurant to catch your own trout and have it prepared for the barbecue or have them cook it for you and served in the dining room.





Day 3



Start the day with a visit to A Maze N Things to enjoy a series of unique and interactive exhibits that entertain, intrigue and stimulate adults for hours. Get lost in Australia's largest timber maze.



As you depart come close with koalas at the Koala Conservation Centre and lunch in the seaside village of Rhyll at The Foreshore Restaurant. Enjoy the tranquil view of Westernport. Enjoy a bottle of local wine while indulging in culinary delights at this popular establishment. Explore the walking trails nearby Rhyll Inlet.



Finish your Phillip Island experience with a scenic helicopter flight and a visit to Churchill Island where you can step back in time to experience the restored homestead, heritage gardens and a historic working farm with Clydesdale horses, highland cattle and animal nursery.
